Policy and Guidelines for the Scholarships & Freeships Support to Students

1. The College shall provide the necessary information at the beginning of the academic year.
2. The College shall notify the list of Government Scholarships. All the notifications/circulars/brochures/ received by the College will be prominently displayed.
3. There is a section in the College office to address the queries & guide the students.
4. The College is registered on various Scholarship Portals of the Government.
5. The College ensures that the Name of the College along with Institutional id/code is there in the portal for the easy and successful submission of the application by the students.
6. The duties of verification, e-verification, attestation, e-attestation are done as per the procedure.
7. The College constituted various committees related to different scholarships so that student may get all the information related to those scholarships & apply timely.
8. These committees are committed to keep the students informed about the scholarships and provide necessary assistance.
9. The scholarship committees shall process all the application on time.
10. The committees shall guide, assist the students and establish liaison with the government department & other agencies as required under the procedure.
11. The information is also displayed on the Students Noticeboards and Noticeboards meant for Scholarship Information.
12. The information of scholarship and freeships portals are also provided.
13. It shall be the duty of the students to register and apply for the available scholarships as per the eligibility criteria.
14. Renewal application alerts shall also be put on the notice board.
15. For any information and assistance on the scholarship the students can contact to concern committee.

Procedures:- At the time of admission itself, the students are given information about various scholarships, the Scholarship Information Systems and Portals of the State Government and Central Government. Students are told to have their bank account and get the Aadhaar seeded to it. Submission of all the particulars such as Income Certificate, Caste Certificate and other applicable documents are mandatory. Information about DBTF (Direct Benefit Transfer) is given as almost all of the Government Scholarships are disbursed directly to the bank account of the beneficiary.

Scholarship Information

1-Scheme Of 'post-Matric Scholarship' For Students Belonging The Minority Communities
It provides a post-matric scholarship for meritorious students of minority communities. The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority communities so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability. Under this scheme financial assistance is provided for admission and tuition fee as well as maintenance allowance which is Rs.3000/- per annum for both hostellers and day scholars.

2-Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan (Pm-Usp) Yojana – Central Sector Scheme Of Scholarship For College And University Students (Pm-Usp Csss)

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies. Under the above scheme scholarship is



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Rs.12000/- per annum at graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at postGraduate level.

3-Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship For Single Girl Child For Pg Programme
The objective of the scheme is to support postgraduate education of single girl child in non-professional courses only. Amount of fellowship is Rs.3100/- per month for two years.

4- Mukhya Mantri Kanya Sumangla Yojana

Women empowerment is one of the commitments of the state govt. of U.P. This vision of women empowerment turned into reality by the launch of **Mukhya Mantri Kanya Sumangla Yojana** in March 2019. This scheme has been implemented in Uttar Pradesh 01/04/2019 and covers six categories of girls. Under this scheme the classification of beneficiary and the amount have been fixed by the state Government. In Degree College, category sixth is applicable. Those girls who after passing their 12th standard exams and took admission in their graduate degree programme are given Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) at one time only.

5- Post – Matric Scholarships

The government of Uttar Pradesh has implemented various scholarship schemes, and among them, the post-matric scholarship stands out as a beacon of hope for students striving to pursue higher education . This scholarship is designed to support students from economically weaker sections who have completed their metric or equivalent examinations and aspire to pursue further studies. The scholarship provides financial assistance to cover various educational expenses, including tuition fees, books, and other essential supplies. It covers a wide range of educational institutions, including universities, college, and technical or vocational institutions. This ensures that students pursuing diverse fields and courses can benefit from the financial assistance provided. The scholarship amount varies based on factors such as the type of course, its duration, and the level of education. This flexibility ensures that the scholarship is tailored to meet the specific needs of different students, recognizing that educational expenses can vary widely.

1: SCHEME OF 'POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES:

1.1: Background behind the scholarship:

The Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities was announced in June, 2006. It provides that a post-matric scholarship scheme for meritorious students from minority communities would be implemented.

1.2 : Objective:

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability.

1.3 : Scope:

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school/college/university, including such residential institutes of the Government and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It will also cover technical and vocational courses in Industrial Training Institutes/ Industrial Training Centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) of classes XI and XII level including Polytechnics and other courses (any course of less than one year duration is not covered under this scheme; Certificate courses are also not covered).

1.4 : Eligibility:

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.



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1.5: Distribution:

Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of five (05) lakh scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides, Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices- A & B).

1.6: Rates of scholarship:

Actual financial assistance will be provided for admission & course /tuition fee and maintenance allowance as given below subject to a maximum ceiling indicated against item. Admission and tuition fee for UG & PG level: Rs. 3,000/- per annum subject to actual (both Hosteller & Day Scholar)

Notes: College is abiding with providing scholarship under all these categories to all expected beneficiaries.

2: PRADHAN MANTRI UCHCHATAR SHIKSHA PROTSAHAN (PM-USP) YOJANA – CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (PM-USP CSSS):

2.1: Objective :

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies

2.2 : Scope:

The scholarships are awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate / postgraduate degree in colleges and universities and for professional courses, such as Medical, Engineering etc.



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2.3: Allocation of Scholarship :

The total number of scholarships are divided amongst the State Education Boards based on the State's population in the age group of 18-25 years, after segregating share of CBSE and ICSE on the basis of number of students passing out from various Boards in the country. 50% of the scholarships are earmarked for girls. Out of the total scholarship slots earmarked for UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, 3% slots shall be earmarked for the students from the UT of Ladakh. The number of scholarships allotted to a State Education Board is distributed amongst pass outs of the Humanities, Science and Commerce streams in the ratio of 3:3:1. In case of shortfall in the number of applications, the scholarship slots shall be interoperable among categories (Gen, OBC, SC & ST), gender (Female, Male) and State Quota to maximize use of slots for fresh scholarships with effect from academic year 2022-23, subject to the condition that guidelines of Ministry of Finance and NITI Aayog regarding SC/ST fund allocation of the schemes are adhered to.

2.4 Eligibility for Scholarship

- i. Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent;
- ii . Pursuing regular degree courses and not correspondence or distance mode or pursuing Diploma courses;
- iii. Pursuing courses at colleges/institutions recognized by All India Council for Technical Education and respective Regulatory Bodies concerned;
- iv. Not availing benefit of any other scholarship schemes including State run scholarship schemes/ fee waiver & reimbursement scheme;
- v. Students with gross parental/family income upto Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarship under the scheme. Income certificate will be required only for the fresh applicants.



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2.5 Rate and Duration of Scholarship:

The rate of scholarship is Rs.12,000/-per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at Post Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/Integrated course will get Rs. 20,000/-per annum in the 4 th and 5th year.

Notes: College is abiding with providing scholarship under all these categories to all expected beneficiaries.

3. Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child For PG Programs:

3.1 OBJECTIVE:

The objectives of the proposed scheme are :

- To support post graduate education of single girl child in non-professional courses only.
- To recognize the value of observance of small family norm.

3.2 ELIGIBILITY:

- Girl students without having any brother or the girl student who are twin daughters/ fraternal daughter may also apply for scholarship under the aforesaid scheme. In a family if one son and one daughter is available then girl child will not be considered for scholarship under the scheme.
- Girl students up to the age of 30 years at the time of admission in PG courses are eligible.



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- iii) The scheme is applicable to such single girl child who has taken admission in regular, fulltime first year Masters Degree course in any designated university or a post graduate college. This scholarship is available to PG-I year student only.
- iv) Admission to PG Course in Distance education mode is not covered under the scheme.

3.4 AMOUNT OF FELLOWSHIP:

@Rs.3100/-per month for two year

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MUKHYA MANTRI KANYA SUMANGLA YOJANA

Women empowerment is one of the commitments of the state govt. of U.P. It has dedication to the goal of upliftment of women in the state. Keeping in view this vision of women empowerment the decision to launch **MukhyaMantriKanyaSumanglaYojana** was taken by the govt. in March 2019. The main aim of this scheme is becomes to stop female feticides, create gender balance, stop vicious practices of child marriage, promote education, create health awareness and make girls of the state self-reliant and develop positive attitudes towards women in the society.

MukhyaMantriKanyaSumanglaYojana has been implemented in Uttar Pradesh since 01/04/2019. In this plan, the girls studying in Govt. colleges and Govt. aided Degree and Post Graduate colleges are asked to apply in order to make them benefited under this scheme. The followings are the terms and eligibility conditions to apply for the benefits of the scheme:

1. The applicant must be a citizen of Uttar Pradesh having a valid residence certificate issued by the competent govt. authority.
2. The annual income of the applicant family should not be more than rupees three lakhs.
3. There must be only two children in the family of the beneficiary of this scheme.
4. Only two girls of a family can have the benefits of this scheme.
5. If the twins are born in a family at the time of the second time of child bearing in a family, the girl born as the third child will also be given the benefits under this scheme. If a woman bears a female child in her first pregnancy and two female children are born in the second pregnancy, then under this condition all three girls will be given benefits under this scheme.
6. If a family has adopted an orphan female child, then including all other alive children of the family, maximum two girls, may be considered eligible for the benefits of this scheme.

KanyaSumanglaYojana covers six categories of girls. Under this scheme the classification of beneficiary and the amount have been fixed by the state Government. In Degree College category sixth is applicable. Those girls who after passing their 12th standard exams taken admissions in their graduate degree programme are given Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) at one time only.

The amount sanctioned by the govt. is transferred to the Bank Account of the beneficiaries by P.F.M.S. The application form is available on portal of **KanyaSumanglaYojna**. The applicants must have photo copy of the Bank Passbook, Residence Certificate, Photo Identify Proof, Family income certificate, Affidavit on prescribed format, latest photo and joint family photo. After submission of the duly completed application form on the website of the said portal, the students submit a copy of the application form in the college which is forwarded to the concerned Govt. authorities.

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The office of the District Magistrate makes physical verification of the applicants and after that the amount is sent to the Bank Account of the applicants.

Our college prepares a list of eligible female students at the time of admissions on the basis of numbers of siblings in the family of the students. On the basis of faculty wise list of such female students a whatsApp group is formed to help the girls under this scheme and their problems are solved accordingly.

Thus, it can be said that this scheme launched by the State Govt. supports the academic pursuits of the girls coming from the economically weaker sections by providing them financial support.
