## Rules and Regulations for Badminton Game (Girls)

1. Each team shall consist of six players.
2. Each match shall comprise three games.
3. The first and third games shall be singles matches, while the second game shall be a doubles match.
4. Players must participate in the order specified by their team captain.
5. Each game shall be played up to 21 points.
6. Players are required to report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time,
7. Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches. If not possible then at least player should wear Sports Shoes
8. All matches shall be played in accordance with the international rules (BWF) of badminton like service, scoring, faults, and other regulations.
9. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.
10. Any player found guilty of cheating or attempting to gain an unfair advantage will be subject to immediate disqualification.
11. All players should bring their own Badminton racquets

## Rules and Regulations for Table-Tennis Game (Girls)

1. Each team shall consist of six players.
2. Each match shall comprise three games.
3. The first and third games shall be singles matches, while the second game shall be a doubles match.
4. Players must participate in the order specified by their team captain.
5. Each game shall be played best of three sets and each set up to 11 points.
6. Players are required to report area at least 15 minutes before their scheduled match time.
7. If Possible then all Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches.
8. All matches shall be played in accordance with the international rules of T.T like service, scoring, faults, and other regulations.
9. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.
10. Any player found guilty of cheating or attempting to gain an unfair advantage will be subject to immediate disqualification.

## Rules and Regulations for Kho-Kho Game (Girls)

1. Each team shall consist of 12 players.
2. Each match shall comprise only one innings, with each team having a turn to chase and defend
3. Each inning shall last for a specified time, 10 minutes.
4. The team with the highest aggregate score at the end of their innings wins the match.
5. Players are required to report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time,
6. If Possible then all Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches
7. All matches shall be played in accordance with the international rules of Kho-Kho
8. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.
9. Any player found guilty of cheating or attempting to gain an unfair advantage will be subject to immediate disqualification.

## Rules and Regulations for Kabaddi Game (Boys)

1. Each team shall consist of 12 players.
2. A Match consist of two half each half shall last for a specified time, 15 minutes.
3. The team with the highest aggregate score at the end wins the match.
4. Players are required to report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time,
5. If Possible then all Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches
6. All matches shall be played in accordance with the international rules of Kabaddi
7. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.
8. Any player found guilty of cheating or attempting to gain an unfair advantage will be subject to immediate disqualification.

## Rules and Regulations for Volleyball Game (Boys)

1. Each team shall consist of 12 players.
2. A Match consists of three sets of 25 points
3. The team win two sets will wins the match.
4. Players are required to report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time,
5. If Possible then all Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches
6. All matches shall be played in accordance with the international rules of Volleyball
7. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.
8. Any player found guilty of cheating or attempting to gain an unfair advantage will be subject to immediate disqualification.

## Rules and Regulations for Cricket Game (Boys)

1. Each team shall consist of 16 players.
2. All Matches will be played with Tennis Ball.
3. The team with the highest aggregate score at the end wins the match.
4. Players are required to report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time,
5. If Possible then all Players must wear appropriate sports attire during matches
6. All matches shall be played in accordance with the modified rules.
7. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to verbal abuse, cheating, or disrespect towards officials, will not be tolerated and may result in penalties or disqualification.

## Rules and Regulations for Tug of War (Boys \& Girls)

1. Each team shall consist of 16 players, with a maximum of 12 players actively participating in each match.
2. Proper footwear, preferably athletic shoes with good traction.
3. Matches shall be conducted in a best-ofthree format.
4. Players must stand behind the designated starting line, with their feet firmly planted and no part of their body touching the ground in front of the line.
5. Teams may employ various techniques, such as leaning back and digging their heels into the ground, to gain leverage.
6. A team wins the pull if they successfully drag the opposing team across the center line, as marked on the rope or indicated by the official
7. After each pull, teams must rotate their players to prevent fatigue and ensure fair participation.
