I am writing to you with regards to the analysis of the feedback collected under Metric 1.4.1 of the NAAC-SSR (National Assessment and Accreditation Council - Self Study Report) of our college. Our commitment to continuous improvement is reflected in our earnest efforts to gather valuable feedback from our students. Through this process, we have identified specific concerns raised by our students that I believe, need your attention.

Firstly, the students have expressed their concern about the vastness of the syllabus for minor papers. They feel that the extensive curriculum poses challenges in terms of preparation and may be a hindrance to their overall academic performance. I kindly request your guidance and support in addressing this matter, possibly through a review of the minor paper syllabi to ensure a balanced and manageable workload for our students.

Secondly, the students have raised their concerns about the frequency of examinations, which they feel, leaves them with insufficient time to adequately prepare for the end-semester exams. I propose a review of the examination schedule, with the aim of creating a more balanced and student-friendly timetable that allows for adequate preparation time.

Additionally, the students have suggested the need for more precise and simplified guidelines for the research project. Clearer instructions would not only enhance the quality of the projects but also alleviate any confusion among students undertaking this academic endeavor.


Student Feedback Analysis

Key Points-

A. Faculty Feedback-

- i. The majority of students have rated faculty members positively in terms of punctuality, completing syllabus on time, regularity, and making alternative class arrangements when absent. Students also appreciate the clarity, understanding, and communication skills of the faculty, with most ratings falling in the excellent and good categories. Classroom discussions and linking subjects to real-life situations received mixed reviews, with some students suggesting potential areas for enhancement.
- **ii.** A significant majority of students (approximately 93.27%) felt that the faculty excelled in encouraging them to ask questions and express opinions, fostering a participatory learning environment. Nearly 92.36% of students rated the faculty as excellent or good in inspiring ethical conduct among students, reflecting a positive influence on their values and behavior.

- **iii.** The majority of students expressed that the faculty effectively promotes classroom discipline, encourages participation, addresses inappropriate behavior, fosters discussion, and inspires ethical conduct.
- iv. Faculty's co-operation in terms of availability for doubt clearing sessions and career guidance received overwhelmingly positive feedback with 91% of students rating it as either excellent or good.
- **v.** The majority of students also reported ease of approaching faculty after classes (90% excellent/good) and the faculty's assistance in helping them realize their strengths and weaknesses (89% excellent/good).
- vi. Student-teacher interaction was highly appreciated, with 93% rating it as either excellent or good.
- **vii.** Faculty's commitment to helping students develop professional and ethical traits also received strong feedback, with 91% rating it as either excellent or good.
- **viii.** Faculty's support in providing extra study material and offering remedial classes for academically weaker students, while positive, has room for improvement (83% and 79% excellent/good, respectively).
- ix. A vast majority of students believe that faculty is committed to helping students irrespective of their gender, ethnicity, and cultural background, with 93% rating it as either excellent or good.

Feedback about college's infrastructure-

Library: The majority of students rated the library infrastructure as either "Good" or

"Excellent," indicating a positive perception of the college's library facilities.

- The availability of books, newspapers, journals, and study material received a balanced response, with a significant percentage rating it as "Good" or "Excellent."
- Students generally perceived a high level of co-operation from the library staff, with over 80% of respondents rating it as "Good" or "Excellent."
- The E-library infrastructure and related services received positive feedback, with a substantial number of students rating them as "Excellent" or "Good."
- Availability of desktops and internet facilities in the E-library were also wellreceived, with the majority of students rating them positively.
- Assistance from E-library staff was considered satisfactory, with more than 80% of respondents rating it as "Good" or "Excellent."

- The students expressed their concern regarding the availability of books, journals and magazines. The students also demanded for a digitalised library. All the concerns were duly addressed by the college administration.

Laboratory:

- 1. **Laboratory Attendance**: A significant percentage (49.1%) of students attended laboratory classes regularly, indicating their commitment to practical learning. However, 15.5% attended often, and 21.5% attended sometimes, suggesting room for improvement in maintaining consistent attendance.
- 2. **Availability of Laboratory Equipment's and Materials:** The majority of students (87.1%) rated the availability of laboratory equipment and materials as either excellent or good. This is a positive sign as it indicates the college is well-equipped.
- 3. **Maintenance of Laboratory**: More than 84.8% of students rated the maintenance of laboratories as either excellent or good, highlighting the college's commitment to keeping the facilities in good condition.
- 4. **Relevance of Laboratory Experiments**: A considerable proportion (86.1%) of students found laboratory experiments extremely relevant or relevant to their coursework.
- 5. **Safety and Comfort During Laboratory Experiments:** The majority (84.6%) felt safe and comfortable during laboratory experiments, which is positive. However, 15.4% reported feeling somewhat or not safe and comfortable, indicating the need for potential improvements in safety measures or communication about safety protocols.
- 6. **Guidance and Support:** A high percentage (83.6%) of students reported receiving adequate guidance and support from faculty and laboratory staff. This indicates strong faculty support in the laboratory, which is crucial for students' learning experiences.

Extra-curricular Activities:

The feedback received from students regarding the college infrastructure is generally positive, with a significant proportion of students satisfied with the organization of cultural activities, practice sessions, and assistance from faculty and staff. However, there are areas where improvement is needed, particularly in ensuring that cultural activities are perceived as extremely well-planned and that practice sessions are organized more consistently.

5. Purified Drinking Water Facilities:

Approximately 86.7% of students indicated that the college provides adequate purified drinking water facilities. While the majority of students are satisfied, there is still room for improvement to ensure that all students have access to clean and safe drinking water.

6. Greenery on Campus:

The presence of greenery on campus is appreciated by the students, with 98% confirming its existence. This not only contributes to the aesthetics of the campus but also enhances the overall college experience.


Demographics of the Faculty:
