Synopsis" organized on 16th Feb, 2022

Addressing the methodology section, Dr. Singh underscored the significance of aligning research methods with the research questions. He encouraged students to be realistic about



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the feasibility of their chosen methodologies. Practical considerations, including the feasibility of the research plan and a realistic timeline, were discussed in detail. Dr. Singh urged participants to critically evaluate the resources required for their study.

In conclusion, the event successfully contributed to the academic growth and preparedness of pre-PhD scholars, setting a positive tone for their research endeavors.
