PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational cooperation on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote sustainable partnerships and mutual understanding between the P.P.N. (PG) College Kanpur (affiliated to C.S.J.M. University, Kanpur) S.N. Sen P.G. College Kanpur Uttar Pradesh, India. Both P.P.N.(PG) College, Kanpur and S.N. Sen P.G. College Kanpur may be referred to individually as the "party" or collectively as the "parties".

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

Pandit Prithi Nath College is a postgraduate college founded in the year 1959 and is now reputed as one of the most prominent educational institutions in Uttar Pradesh. It is located at Mall Road, Parade Crossing, Colonel Ganj, Kanpur of Uttar Pradesh state. It is affiliated with Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj (C.S.J.M.) University, Kanpur and approved by UGC. P.P.N. (PG) College is one of the premiere educational institutions of Uttar Pradesh. The college is proud of imparting the best education in 19 Undergraduate and 13 Postgraduate subjects in Arts, Science, Commerce, Business Administration, Computer Applications and BTC against minimum amount of fee in the city.

P.P.N.(PG) College, Kanpur and S.N. Sen P.G. College Kanpur aim to undertake cooperation in areas that may include, but are not restricted to, the following:

a) Student exchange for research and study

- b) Exchange of faculty, staff and research scholars
- c) Joint research activities
- e) Continuing education programs
- f) Organization and participation in seminars, symposia, short-term academic programs and academic meetings
- g) Exchange of research and educational materials, publications and academic information
- h) Technical assistance.
- i) Other, with mutual consent of both the parties

ACTIVITY AGREEMENTS

Before any activities may be implemented, the parties shall discuss the relevant issues to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements based on the mutually agreed objectives and outcomes of the activity. Activity agreements will include such terms as the following:

- a) Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed upon activity.
- b) Specific schedules for the activity.
- c) Budgets and sources of finances for the activity.
- d) Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publications.
- e) Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

Obligations:

Both the organizations acknowledge the fact that no contractual relationship has been created out of this MOU and they agree to work in unison towards their respective goals and targets to make this collaboration a success and thereby exemplify the spirit of transparency and responsibility.

Use of Logo/Name

“Permission is given to both the parties to use the official marks of the other party specifically the institutional name and/or institutional logo solely for the purposes of promoting and administering the collaborative activities between the institutions; Provided, that the party using the official marks of the other party shall take all such reasonable degree of care as an institution of good ethical and normal prudence would expect in its own case.”



Arbitration and Jurisdiction:

In case of any dispute arising between the parties in respect to any of the terms in this MOU, the parties undertake to settle the same by issuing a notice within 30 days from the date of the issue becoming known to either party. In case no such settlement is arrived at after mutual negotiations, the matter may be resolved by arbitration and shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 subject to any statutory modification, amendment

or re-enactment, from time to time.

RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

- a) This MOU shall remain in force for a period of **One year** from the date of the last signature. This MOU may be extended by the written consent of the parties.
- b) This MOU may be terminated by either party giving written notice to the other party at least 30 days in advance of the stated termination date. Termination of this MOU shall not affect activities in progress pursuant to specific activity agreements, which shall continue until concluded by the parties in accordance with their terms or as otherwise agreed to by the parties in writing.
- c) This MOU may be amended only by the written consent of the parties.
