1. Parties to the Agreement

This agreement, made and entered on 05thday of June 2022, is between the Talent Development Council (henceforth called TDC) with its address at 2A/121, Azad Nagar, Kanpur-208002, UP and PPN PG College, Kanpur (henceforth called PPN College), with its address at 96/12, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Kanpur, UP.

The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment or termination and expiration unless otherwise agreed by the two parties.

5. Duration

This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signature and remain in force fortwoyear unless terminated by mutual agreement in writing.


