





WWF-India and PPN College MOU on undertaking tasks/studies on
"Impact Assessment of Receding Wetlands on livelihood of Rural Population: A Study of
Wetlands of Lucknow District of Uttar Pradesh, India "

WWF-India under its Small Grants Innovation Programme (SGIP) is desirous to encourage conservation and research as per the objectives of the SGIP and PPN College has agreed to implement the project "Impact Assessment of Receding Wetlands on livelihood of Rural Population: A Study of Wetlands of Lucknow District of Uttar Pradesh, India " for which financial support will be provided by WWF-India. A detailed curriculum vita of the implementer is attached at Annexure 1.

Details of activities to be carried out by PPN College are as set out in the terms of the proposal submitted to WWF-India and attached as Annexure 2. (hereinafter referred to as "Proposal").

To facilitate and clarify this agreement, WWF-India and PPN College hereby enter into a memorandum of understanding to effectively complete the tasks / studies.

WWF-India and PPN College agree that:

1. WWF-India will pay PPN College a lump sum amount not exceeding **INR 4,00,000/- (INR Four Lakh only)** as financial support, subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in this MoU.
2. PPN College shall pay all applicable taxes on the fee/ payment received from WWF-India under the terms of this contract and shall not hold WWF-India liable for the payment of any taxes to be paid on such fees/payment received from WWF-India.
3. PPN College will work in close coordination with the SGIP team at WWF-India which will conduct periodic review of the project with PPN College in order to assess the progress of the project.
4. Timeframe of the assignment is 24 months starting from the date of signing the MoU by both the parties.
5. The funds will be transferred in three installments by WWF-India to PPN College as provided under the Schedule of payment in Section D of this MoU, by Electronic Bank Transfer
6. At the end of the project period PPN college will submit a final project report and expenditure statement as per the budget mentioned in Annexure II.
7. This MoU and all matters arising out of or in connection with it shall be confidential between PPN college and WWF -India, except:
 - a. Approved by WWF-India after discussion with PPN College.
 - b. As to what may from time to time become public knowledge.



8. No deviation from the approved Proposal annexed and its activities shall be permitted, without WWF-India's written consent.
9. Apart from abiding by the Terms of Reference cited in the "Proposal", the project team member/s from PPN college may be asked in written to attend meeting, workshop, and capacity building program conducted by WWF-India or its partners in any part of the country. In such a case, WWF India will give a prior notice to PPN College.
10. WWF -India shall not be liable for the insurance coverage or compensation to PPN College or team designated for this project, in case of injuries/death caused by accident or otherwise arising out of and in the course of working on the project.
11. All information and material, including photographs, obtained/generated during the implementation of the project and under this agreement will/shall remain the joint property of PPN college and WWF-India. WWF-India reserves the rights to future use and publication of the content with due credit to PPN college.
12. PPN college will have intellectual property rights over the data and information generated which can be used by PPN college for scientific publications and presentations in different forums. However, prior consent of WWF-India will be required in all such cases. PPN college will ensure that WWF India is duly acknowledged in these publications and presentations.

7. Termination:



**Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Cooperation
Between**

(Statutory Body under an Act of Parliament)**

PPN Degree College, Kanpur (PPN Kanpur) and The Institute of Cost Accountants of India Kanpur Chapter of Cost Accountants (KCCA) recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of Costing, Auditing, Financial services, management and social sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

PPN Kanpur and KCCA therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

A. Objectives

The goal is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for global experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree:

- a) to exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
- c) to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- e) to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- f) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, (Foundation) Graduate (Intermediate) and (Final) Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.

PPN Kanpur and KCCA further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between PPN Kanpur and KCCA.

C. Exchange of Faculty and Staff

PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms.

D. Student Exchange

PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- f) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.

E. Joint Conferences, workshops and short-term courses

PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between PPN Kanpur and KCCA

F. Intellectual Property

PPN Kanpur and KCCA agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MOU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

PPN College Kanpur and KCCA agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

G. Co-ordination


Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Principal, PPN College Kanpur, or his/her nominee, (b) Chairman, KCCA, or his/her nominee, (c) Programme coordinator from the side of PPN College Kanpur, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of KCCA, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.


H. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for **three years**, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither PPN Kanpur nor KCCA will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, PPN College Kanpur and KCCA will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

I. Arbitration Clause

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principal, PPN College Kanpur and Chairman, KCCA will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

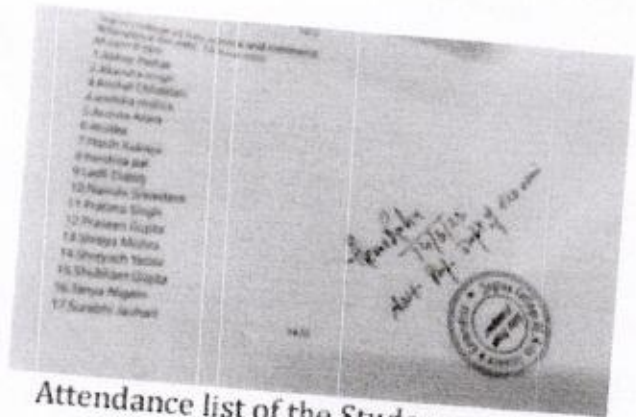

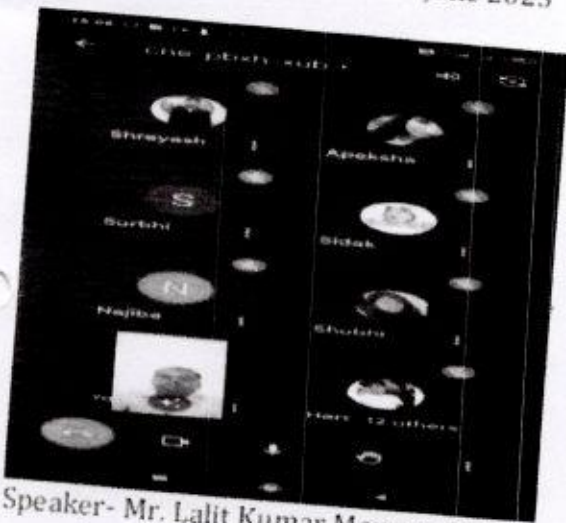

Preamble

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

I. Faculty Exchange

- a) The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions,
- b) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest,
- c) Conducting lectures,
- d) Undertaking joint research,
- e) Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions .

II. Student Exchange

PPN Kanpur and JC Kanpur agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate/ postgraduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence

between courses taken at the host institution viz-a-viz those offered at the home institution.

- g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- h) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.
- i) PPN Kanpur and JC Kanpur agree to arrange for classes/lecture for student exchange.
- j) The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

III. Research:

- a) to exchange information on research and educational programs,
- b) to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs,
- c) to jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- d) to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- e) to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- f) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research,
- g) to encourage the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities
- h) to use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period,
- i) to permit students and faculty members to use library facility.
- j) PPN and JC agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint two members of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of PPN Kanpur, and a programme coordinator from the side of JC Kanpur, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Both the institutions does not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both institutes to this Memorandum.

Both institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing.

Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of one year commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither PPN Kanpur nor JC Kanpur will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, PPN Kanpur and JC Kanpur will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 7: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

ARTICLE 8: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating faculties and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the present country/UGC and rules and regulations of the institutions.


ARTICLE 9: LEGAL EFFECT
